Serpentine Loop 3 Cones Point Value 40	- Handler continuously praising and talking to the dog while heeling - Handler continually adapting to the dog's pace - Dog Barks continuously - Constant tight leash or guiding - Failure of the team to weave between the cones	Constantly sniffing	- Crowding, forging, lagging, wide, improper heel position or imperfections, sniffing - Bumping a cone - Failure of handler to maintain constant pace through cones - Dog does not change pace while weaving between cones		
Sit for Exam Point Value 40	- Handler holds dog or prevents dog from moving <i>after</i> stay command - Dog moves away <i>after</i> stay command - Dog changes position <i>before</i> or <i>during</i> exam - Dog barks continuously - Judge is unable to examine dog	- Resists being placed in a sit position - Unnecessary roughness - Handler not reasonably close when giving stay command and/or signal - Touches dog while giving command and/or signal to stay	- Dog changes position or moves a short distance <i>after</i> examination but before exercise finished - Dog shows shyness or resentment before, during, or after exam		
Down Stay Point Value 40	- Dog refuses to down - Dog sits or stands <i>before</i> handler returns - Dog barks continuously - Dog crawls more than a body length away <i>after</i> stay command/signal	- Resists being placed in a down position - Unnecessary roughness - Handler not reasonably close when giving stay command and/or signal - Touches dog when giving signal - Crawls more than a short distance <i>after</i> stay command - Dog sits or stands after handler returns - Handler fails to return correctly	Depending on the extent of the deviation from the ideal a major or minor deduction may be incurred		
Straight Recall Point Value 40	- Moves out of position <i>after</i> handler commands/signals dog to stay - Anticipates recall - Fails to come to handler - Fails to come within and arm's length of the handler	- Dog stands/downs <i>after</i> stay command - Dog is slow to respond - Handler takes more than 3 steps backwards when calling dog	Depending on the extent of the deviation from the ideal a major or minor deduction may be incurred
